This is certainly a sustained response to the text and to the importance of Jack and details are effectively chosen in response to the candidate's interpretation of Jack. The effects of Jack's hair, his eyes and his mask are all clearly explained. Indeed, all Band 3 is clearly fulfilled. The idea of Jack's resemblance to the fire is certainly thoughtful and lifts the response into Band 4; thus a mark of 16 was awarded.

Question 21

This response is clearly weaker than that in Section A. The response never gets past explained and there are details used to support a range of comments. The candidate does explain how Steinbeck uses Candy's dog to say something about Candy, thus achieving one bullet in Band 3. The response is weaker in terms of its response to contexts. Certainly, there is a supported response to Candy's situation on the ranch [Band 1] and this becomes explained later in part b). However, details are lacking in both bands. A mark of 9 was awarded.
